

Booster Club/Parent Teacher Fellowship Kickoff Minutes

Welcome/Opening Remarks by Gail Murphy: Ms. Murphy commented on selecting officers at the end of the meeting. She also talked about the upcoming Fall Festival which is October 3, 2009. The sales of tickets cover the cost of the event.

Benefit Auction Introduction: Mr. Sammy Hatchell – heads the Benefit Auction and Golf Tournament

- Benefit Auction will be November 6 at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel on I-40. Mr. Hatchell mentioned a possible person to be the guest speaker. Tickets should stay the same as last year with the cost being \$25.00 per person, to sponsor a table of 10 guests probably \$200 (TBD). (The ticket sales cover the expense of the event.) The auction (both silent and live) will be the source of donated funds for the school.
- Golf Tournament will be May 3 at the Preserve Golf Course, which is located between Chapel Hill and Pittsboro, same location as in 2009. The cost for the tournament, meal, and amenities is \$200.00 for people outside of CCA; the price for parents and grandparents is \$100.00. Golf prizes will be awarded.

Booster Club Overview: Mr. Vern Parsons

- Talked about the purpose of the Booster Club was to support athletics. There are approximately 200 athletic functions within a year.
- Football program has been canceled for the 2009 season due to lack of student participation.
- Introduced coaches in the room: Mr. Hatchell – varsity basketball; Mr. Winston – middle school basketball; Mr. McDonald – cross country; Mr.

Clayton – golf; Mrs. Warren – middle school girls' volleyball; and Mr. Bollinger.

- Mr. Parsons talked about there being no I in team, example girls' volleyball.
