

# Cresset Christian Academy – School Wear 2010-11

## Girls—K5-Grade 12

**For regular school hours: 7:30 a.m.—4:00 p.m**

*(Administrators retain the right to judge the propriety of clothing for a school setting.)*

### Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday

#### **Shorts, Skorts, or Pants**

Shorts—Modest khaki-style shorts, dress shorts, no more than 3 inches above the top of the knee

Pants – Modestly loose khaki-style pants, dress pants, or Capris

*(K-Grade 5 girls may wear jeans, except on Chapel Day)*

#### **Skirts, Gauchos, or Dresses with sleeves**

Knee-length or longer (Grades 3-12)

Slits in skirts no higher than knee length

Necklines in dresses must fall no more than 1” below the collarbone.

#### **Shirts, Blouses, Sweaters, Hoodies, Sweatshirts**

Necklines in shirts and blouses must fall no more than 1” below the collarbone. *(Inserts may be available for sale in the school office if a shirt falls below the 1” guideline for modesty.)*

Tops must have a modestly loose fit.

Bare skin may not be visible between tops and bottoms.

Shirts and blouses must have sleeves and may be worn untucked.

Shirts or blouses *with* collars are worn with pants or skirts.

Button shirts (must be buttoned if worn as top garment)

Polo-style shirts

Shirts *without* collars may be worn only with skirts *(Must wear collared shirt with pants.)*

Sweaters or hoodies worn over a collared shirt

Sweatshirts over a collared shirt *(No sweatshirts on Chapel Day)*

**Shoes:** Athletic, dress shoes, or sandals *(Strongly recommended for elementary: shoes with backs and toes)*

### Chapel Day Thursday (unless specially called for another day)

**K5-Grade 2** Dress with sleeves or skirt and blouse

**Grades 3-12** Knee-length or longer dress or skirt and blouse or sweater

**K5-Grade 12 (November through February)** dress slacks and dressy blouse with sleeves and collar.

Maintain the modesty guidelines with loose fitting tops and bottoms, as well as the 1” neckline guide.

*(No shorts, jeans, or sweatshirts on Thursdays)*

- **Evening (after 4), athletic events, and dress down days:** Students may wear modest casual wear, in addition to the guidelines above, including: jeans, T-shirts without offensive slogans, athletic jerseys, and pants. Bare skin may not be visible between tops and bottoms. Modesty guidelines apply.
- **For girls out of dress code:** Clean collared shirts, pants, skirts may be available in the school office. Return them, clean, within 5 days or a charge will be placed on the school account.
- **Please label** all clothing. Labeled clothing can be returned if misplaced. Unlabeled clothing is given to a charity monthly. Check in the school office for lost items.
