

## WHAT IS NEW IN THE 2018-2019 STUDENT HANDBOOK?



**Admissions:** Each new student begins on a nine-week probation. Probation ends when each course has a 70% or better score and all behavioral discipline has been completed.

**Financial Assistance:** Forms submitted after April 25 will be processed as funds are available.

**Report cards:** Report cards may be withheld pending outstanding balances.

**Absences:** Sickness is excused for the first 2 days with a parent note; after two days a doctor's note is required for an excused absence.

**Upper School Student Pledge:** I understand that failure to (uphold the high standards of Cresset Christian Academy), ... including all social media, may result in disciplinary action...

**Temporary removal from classroom** (middle or high school): Teacher records problem in a RenWeb behavior note to parents, after discussion with the student, with 0 demerits.

**Penalties for Major Offenses:** Possession or use of tobacco products, including e-cigarette paraphernalia, Level 4, two penalties, one day in-school suspension and conference with administrator and parent.

**School Dress Code (Grades K-12):** **Boys** shirts must have collar and sleeves. Sweat pants are not in dress code. **Girls** may not wear leggings alone as pants, but only with tunic tops 4" above the knee or longer. Sweat pants are not in dress code.

**Dress code violation:** Go to office to change clothes.

**Before school:** students of all ages arriving before 7:45 am will go to the assigned designated areas.

**After school:** students of all ages on campus after 3:30 will go to assigned designated areas.

**Carpooling, student drivers:** Students are not allowed to leave campus after school with a student driver, unless written permission from the parent has been given to the office.

**Visitors, alumni:** registered visitors and alumni should be in dress code.
